 - Requested bond is \$165 Million for (but not limited to):

 - Additional Safety and security updates
 - New Agriculture Science Center to serve FJH and FHS
 - Turf for baseball and softball field
 - Additional football practice field for band, wranglerettes, and other sports as to not use the parking lot for routine practice.
 - lockers for Cheerleaders
 - FISD Currently
 - 6144 students enrolled in FISD schools
 - 99% graduation rate
 - Students average 200 pts higher on SATs than surrounding schools
 - 69% graduation rate
 - Just completed all Items on the 2020 Bond including:
 - Replaced Cline with a new build
 - Added classrooms to Westwood
 - Bales received classroom renovations
 - Friendswood High School received upgrades across the board including a new competition gym, PAC, and other renovations to many other programs/facilities
 - Windsong had classrooms added
